

Recommendations

Behave as if you have the infection but it doesn't show.

Behave as if your neighbor has the infection but it doesn't show.

Stay aware of your health. Seek medical attention quickly if you show symptoms of infection.

Those 60 years and older, especially those with underlying health conditions, should minimize their potential for exposure to infected individuals.

COVID-19 Symptoms

Symptoms of COVID-19 include cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, or at least two of the following symptoms: chills, shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, and loss of taste or smell. Symptoms can range from mild to severe and may appear up to two weeks after exposure to the virus, according to the CDC. Some people with COVID-19 don't display any symptoms.

Seek medical attention if you experience serious symptoms such as trouble breathing or pain or pressure in the chest.

Characteristics of COVID-19

Some infected individuals show no symptoms of infection; so called, asymptomatic carriers.

The disease is highly contagious. Single infected individuals have spread the disease to exposed community in a single setting (e.g., birthday party, choir practice); so called super carrier events.

The measured mortality rate in Harrison county among the infected is 10% (as of May 19, 2020).

The measured mortality rate is age related. All county fatalities were in the 60+ age group. The mortality rate for those infected in this age group is 16% (as of May 18, 2020); **1 out of 6**.

Assembly Participation

Option 1: Sunday morning 10:30 AM worship will be the only assembly held at the building. Nursery staffing will not be resumed at this time. Additional assemblies will be added as experience and conditions improve.

Option 2: Live broadcast of the Sunday AM worship will be only available on the conference call line. The conference call line will be recorded for later play-back.

Options 3 and 4: The Face Book video feed and associated links to the church website for video viewing will be recorded and uploaded following the morning assembly.

If you or a family member are 60+ years old with underlying health conditions, you are encouraged to forego assembly at the building and participate in one of the on-line assembly options.

All worship attendees should do a symptom check on assembly days. If you are in less than regular good health or have recently (within 14 days) been in contact with someone who is ill, you are encouraged to forego assembly at the building and participate in one of the on-line assembly options.

Safety When In Numbers

The use of Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) (face masks, gloves, eye glasses, etc.) is encouraged during the assembly.

Social distancing at all times is encouraged.

Practice cleanliness everywhere. Please clean up after yourself and your children in the building, including pews and rest rooms. Leave nothing you brought in the pew when you leave.

Frequent use of sanitizers and hand washing when possible is encouraged each time you transition from one area to a new area (e.g., car to building, building to rest room, building to car, etc).

Deposit trash in trash cans upon leaving the building.

Exit the building practicing social distancing.

Conduct small group visits outside the building in open air.

Safely dispose of or clean potentially contaminated PPE and clothing to minimize future contamination.

Refrain from unnecessary contact with commonly used surfaces.

Precautionary Adjustments

Please enter and exit using the foyer doors only. They will be left open until services start; no need to touch door handles.

Pre-filled communion, trash bags, and bottled water will be handed out by a gloved deacon at the foyer entry; no passing of trays.

Designated seating areas will be marked to maintain social distancing guidelines.

Bulletins and calendars will be mailed to homes; no common pick-up stack at building.

Contributions should be mailed to the office or may be left in the suggestion box; no common collection will be taken at the assembly.

Attendance will be recorded visually; no attendance card handling in the assembly.

Songs will be displayed on the overhead projector; no song book handling in the assembly.

Trash bags will be provided for self-disposal of Lord's Supper serving wrapper, water bottles, tissues, etc.

Sanitizer will be provided at the foyer entrance. Sanitizer and soap will be provided in each rest room.
